Description	Expectations/Options	What's not allowed
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Advisory period will be in the morning after 1st/5th period (30 minute Intervention).● May not transfer out of advisory period for another teacher.● Student expectations: come with work to complete. If they don't have work, their options are silent sustained reading, Get More Math, Edgenuity, or intervention assignments.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Teachers will do a one on one weekly check in with each advisory student.★ Daily to do list for students:<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Check email-Check Google Classroom-Check Aeries-Read the bulletin (again)★ Students <u>may not leave advisory classroom</u>, but may email teachers with questions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ No club/class meetings★ No leaving campus★ No free time- you must be working on an assignment, emailing a teacher, checking grades, working on Get More Math or My Path, or reading silently.
