Through HelpNow, live real-time homework assistance is available 24 hours a day. Assistance in other languages available including Spanish. State Library HelpNow Info page, start session page</p>
	<p>PebbleGo Science (Capstone)</p>	<p>PebbleGo is a curricular content hub specifically designed for K-2 students from Capstone. COMPASS provides PebbleGo Science to support STEM learning in English and Spanish, as well as 50 interactive STEM eBooks from Capstone. See pebblego.com/california</p>
	<p>Britannica School (Britannica)</p>	<p>General informational resource, segmented by levels (elementary, middle, high school). Three reading levels of the articles, Merriam-Webster's double-click dictionary, images, videos, and interactive tools. Text translate and audio reader of articles in English. Go to school.eb.com</p>
	<p>Britannica Escolar (Britannica)</p>	<p>General information resource written in native Spanish. Segmented by elementary and middle school levels. Includes text, images, video, and games. Auto-audio feature in Spanish. Puede leer y escuchar en español. Go to escolar.eb.com</p>
	<p>National Geographic Kids (Gale)</p>	<p>Suite of content from National Geographic Kids, including full articles from years of the magazine, books published as part of the NatGeo Kids library, and specialized videos. More information at https://support.gale.com/cak12</p>
	<p>Gale in Context: Environmental Studies (Gale)</p>	<p>Specialized suite of content at the middle school and high school levels that specifically addresses issues and topics related to the environment, from the science concepts to manmade impacts to policy. 	<p>Gale Interactive: Science</p>	<p>This interactive tool includes 3D modules and interactive components to explore science – anatomy, chemistry, biology, earth science. 	SIRS Issues Researcher (ProQuest)*	<p>Curriculum-aligned database of content on complex subjects geared to middle and high school students and educators, with a focus on current and relevant analysis of today's most important controversial issues.</p>
	eLibrary (ProQuest)*	<p>General reference aggregation of periodical and digital media content with editorial guidance to help choose research topics and find authoritative information to support research claims.</p>
	Research Companion (ProQuest)*	<p>Series of information video modules that guide the student into the process of writing research papers.</p>
	ProQuest eBooks Central*	<p>Also known as School & Educators Complete. Suite of eBooks from ProQuest across a variety of disciplines.</p>

	ProQuest Central Student **	College level academic database with millions of articles and other content. (**Only available to public schools via the district or charter.)
	PBS Video Collection **	Collection of more than 1,500 streaming videos of educational documentaries and series from PBS. (**Only available to public schools via the district or charter.)
